A member may appoint one or more proxies to attend and vote in his stead. ANY ALTERATION MADE TO THIS FORM OF PROXY MUST BE INITIALLED BY THE PERSON(S) WHO SIGN(S) IT.
4. IMPORTANT: IF YOU WISH TO VOTE FOR A RESOLUTION, TICK THE RELEVANT BOX MARKED “FOR”. IF YOU WISH TO VOTE AGAINST A RESOLUTION, TICK THE RELEVANT BOX MARKED “AGAINST”. Failure to tick either box will entitle your proxy to cast your vote or abstain at his discretion. Your proxy will also be entitled to vote or abstain at his discretion on any resolution properly put to the said meeting other than that referred to in the notice convening the meeting.
5. The instrument appointing proxy must be in writing under the hand of the appointor or his attorney duly authorised in writing, if the appointor being a corporation, either under its seal or under the hand of an officer, attorney or other person duly authorised to sign the same.
6. Any member of the Company entitled to attend and vote at the meeting shall be entitled to appoint another person (who must be an individual) as his proxy to attend and vote instead of him. On a poll votes may be given either personally or by proxy. A proxy need not be a member of the Company. A member who holds two or more shares of the Company may appoint more than one proxy to attend and vote on the same occasion.
7. The instrument appointing a proxy and the power of attorney or other authority, if any, under which it is signed or a certified copy of that power or authority shall deposited at the branch share registrar and transfer office of the Company in Hong Kong, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited at 17M Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen’s Road East, Wan Chai, Hong Kong, not later than 48 hours before the time appointed for holding the meeting or any adjourned meeting at which the person named in such instrument proposes to vote, and in default the instrument of proxy shall not be treated as valid. Delivery of any instrument of appointing a proxy shall not preclude a member from attending and voting in person at the meeting or at any adjourned meeting or poll concerned and, in such event, the instrument appointing the proxy shall be deemed to be revoked.
8. Where there are joint registered holders of any share, any one of such persons may vote at the meeting, either personally or by proxy, in respect of such share as if he/she was solely entitled thereto; but if more than one of such joint holders be present at the meeting personally or by proxy, that one of the said person so present being the most or, as the case may be, the more senior shall alone be entitled to vote in respect of the relevant joint holding and, for this purpose, seniority shall be determined by reference to the order in which the names of the joint holders stand on the register in respect of the relevant joint holding.

- (iv) By providing your proxy’s Personal Data in this form, you acknowledge that you have; (1) informed your proxy of the purpose for and manner in which his/her Personal Data may be used; and (2) obtained your proxy’s express consent to use his/her Personal Data for such purpose and in such manner.
